#201-250, John 18:7 to Romans 12:19

#201 John 18:7 Whom do you seek?

#202 John 20:21 “Peace be with you; as the Father has sent Me, I also send you

#203 John 20:27 and do not be unbelieving, but believing

#204 John 21:15 Tend My lambs

#205 John 21:16 Shepherd My sheep

#206 John 21:17 Tend My sheep

#207 John 21:19 Follow Me!

#208 John 21:22 You follow Me!

#209 Acts 1:7 It is not for you to know times or epochs which the Father has fixed by His own authority

#210 Acts 1:8 and you shall be My witnesses both in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and even to the remotest part of the earth

#211 Acts 2:21 AND IT SHALL BE THAT EVERYONE WHO CALLS ON THE NAME OF THE LORD WILL BE SAVED

#212 Acts 2:38 Repent, and each of you be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins; and you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit

#213 Acts 2:40 Be saved from this perverse generation!

#214 Acts 3:39 Therefore repent and return, so that your sins may be wiped away, in order that times of refreshing may come from the presence of the Lord

#215 Acts 4:19 Whether it is right in the sight of God to give heed to you rather than to God, you be the judge

#216 Acts 4:29 And now, Lord, take note of their threats, and grant that Your bond-servants may speak Your word with all confidence

#217 Acts 5:29 We must obey God rather than men

#218 Acts 15:29 that you abstain from things sacrificed to idols and from blood and from things strangled and from fornication

#New Testament Commandments Part 5 – NASB
#201-250, John 18:7 to Romans 12:19

#219 Acts 16:31 Believe in the Lord Jesus, and you will be saved, you and your household

#220 Acts 20:35 It is more blessed to give than to receive

#221 Romans 1:17 BUT THE RIGHTEOUS man SHALL LIVE BY FAITH

#222 Romans 2:13 for it is not the hearers of the Law who are just before God, but the doers of the Law will be justified

#223 Romans 2:21 You who preach that one shall not steal, do you steal?

#224 Romans 2:22 You who say that one should not commit adultery, do you commit adultery?

#225 Romans 2:22 You who abhor idols, do you rob temples?

#226 Romans 6:11 Even so consider yourselves to be dead to sin, but alive to God in Christ Jesus

#227 Romans 6:12 Therefore do not let sin reign in your mortal body so that you obey its lust

#228 Romans 6:13 and do not go on presenting the members of your body to sin as instruments of unrighteousness

#229 Romans 6:13 but present yourselves to God as those alive from the dead, and your members as instruments of righteousness to God

#230 Romans 6:14 For sin shall not be master over you

#231 Romans 6:19 so now present your members as slaves to righteousness, resulting in sanctification

#232 Romans 6:23 For the wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord

#233 Romans 10:9 that if you confess with your mouth Jesus as Lord, and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you will be saved

#234 Romans 10:11 WHOEVER BELIEVES IN HIM WILL NOT BE DISAPPOINTED

#235 Romans 10:13 for “WHOEVER WILL CALL ON THE NAME OF THE LORD WILL BE SAVED

#236 Romans 10:17 So faith comes from hearing, and hearing by the word of Christ

#237 Romans 12:1 Therefore I urge you, brethren, by the mercies of God, to present your bodies a living and holy sacrifice, acceptable to God, which is your spiritual service of worship

#New Testament Commandments Part 5 – NASB
#201-250, John 18:7 to Romans 12:19

#238 Romans 12:2 And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, so that you may prove what the will of God is

#238 Romans 12:3 not to think more highly of himself than he ought to think; but to think so as to have sound judgment

#239 Romans 12:6 Since we have gifts that differ according to the grace given to us, each of us is to exercise them accordingly

#240 Romans 12:9 Let love be without hypocrisy

#241 Romans 12:9 Abhor what is evil; cling to what is good

#242 Romans 12:10 Be devoted to one another in brotherly love; give preference to one another in honor; not lagging behind in diligence, fervent in spirit, serving the Lord; rejoicing in hope, persevering in tribulation, devoted to prayer, contributing to the needs of the saints, practicing hospitality

#243 Romans 12:14 Bless those who persecute you; bless and do not curse

#244 Romans 12:15 Rejoice with those who rejoice, and weep with those who weep

#245 Romans 12:16 Be of the same mind toward one another; do not be haughty in mind, but associate with the lowly

#246 Romans 12:16 Do not be wise in your own estimation

#247 Romans 12:17 Never pay back evil for evil to anyone

#248 Romans 12:17 Respect what is right in the sight of all men

#249 Romans 12:17 If possible, so far as it depends on you, be at peace with all men

#250 Romans 12:19 Never take your own revenge, beloved, but leave room for the wrath of God
