

The Resurrection – NASB Near the Passover, Jesus death and resurrection, April 1, 2018	
Resurrection	A standing up again, a resurrection from death, recovery, raised to Life again
Meaning	Aren't those terms sufficient to explain our new birth?
Why is it Important?	Witnesses the immense power of God – To Believe in the Resurrection is to believe in God.
	Validates Jesus Claims: He was the Son of God and Messiah:
	Matthew 12:39 ...no sign shall be given to it but the sign of Jonah the prophet;
	Mark 9:31 (Jesus) and they will kill Him; and when He has been killed, He will rise three days later."
	Proves Jesus Christ sinless character and divine nature
	Psalms 16:10 ...Neither wilt Thou allow <u>Thy Holy One</u> to undergo decay.
	Validates Old Testament Prophets:
	Acts 17:3 (Paul) explaining and <u>giving evidence</u> that the Christ had to suffer and rise again from the dead,(Paul is preaching from Old Testament)
	<u>There is no resurrection (to life) apart from Christ Unbelievers rose to judgement</u>
	John 11:25 Jesus said "I am the resurrection and the life; he who believes in Me shall live even if he dies,

Death to Hope	1st Corinthians 15:21 For since by a man [came] death, by a man also [came] the resurrection of the dead.
	Term Resurrection Not listed in the Old Testament. Reason – not listed, but might be talked.
	Genesis 49:18 "For Thy salvation I wait, O LORD.
Why not used?	Colossians 1:18 ...He is the beginning, the first-born from the dead... (Jesus not resurrected)
1 st usage (Jesus)	Matthew 22:23 On that day [some] Sadducees (who say there is no resurrection) came to Him and questioned Him
Resurrection =	Acts 2:24 "And God raised Him up again, putting an end to the agony of death...
Act of Godhead	John 10:18 (Jesus talking)... I have authority to lay it down, and I have authority to take it up again.
F/S/HS	1 st Peter 3:18 but made alive in the Spirit ;
Resurrection Confirmed by Jesus	Mark 14:28 (Jesus talking) "But after I have been raised, I will go before you to Galilee."
	<u>Ten different appearances of Jesus in NT after burial: - not just hear say!</u>
1	John 20:18 Mary Magdalene at the tomb alone.
2	Matthew 28:9 the other Mary...and others, as they returned from the Tomb
3	Luke 24:34 Simon Peter alone on the day of the resurrection
4	Luke 24:15 Disciples on the way to Emmaus
5	Luke 24:36 To the ten disciples, without Thomas
6	Mark 16:14 To the disciples again (Thomas being present)
7	John 21:1 To the disciples when fishing at the Sea of Galilee
8	1 st Corinthians 15:6 To the eleven, and above 500 brethren at once
9	1 st Corinthians 15:7 To James

	Ten different continued
10	Mark 16:19 To the Apostles immediately before the ascension Meetings – great stories with much emotion, loving on Jesus, Jesus loving.
	2 types of Resurrection
Everyone Resurrected	John 5:29 and shall come forth; those who did the good [deeds] to a resurrection of life , those who committed the evil [deeds] to a resurrection of judgment . Only need one good deed = accepting Jesus Christ as your Savior. (Death Bed Conversion)
We believe in Jesus	John 5:24 Truly, truly, I say to you, he who hears My word, and believes Him who sent Me, has eternal life, and does not come into judgment, but has passed out of death into life.
Raising Lazarus	John 11:25 Jesus said to her, I am the resurrection and the life ; he who believes in Me shall live even if he dies,
Albert Barnes Commentary	I am the resurrection. I am the author or the cause of the resurrection. It so depends on my power and will, that it may be said that I am the resurrection itself
Apostle Selection	Acts 1:22...one of these should become a witness with us of His resurrection (Judas replaced)
Resistance naming Jesus	Acts 4:2 being greatly disturbed because they were teaching the people and proclaiming in Jesus the resurrection from the dead .
Jewish Belief/Unbelief	Sadducees say that there is no resurrection, nor an angel, nor a spirit; but the Pharisees Acts 23:6-7 But perceiving that one part were Sadducees and the other Pharisees, Paul [began] crying out in the Council, "Brethren, I am a Pharisee, a son of Pharisees; I am on trial for the hope and resurrection of the dead!" (Paul)
Hot topic	Acts 23:9 And there arose a great uproar; and some of the scribes of the Pharisaic party stood up and [began] to argue heatedly, saying, "We find nothing wrong with this man; suppose a spirit or an angel has spoken to him?"
HS Power is Proof of Resur	Acts 4:33 And with great power the apostles were giving witness to the resurrection... Acts 26:23 that the Christ was to suffer, [and] that by reason of [His] resurrection from the dead He should be the first to proclaim light both to the [Jewish] people and to the Gentiles.
Proof of God's Son	Romans 1:4 who was declared the Son of God with power by the resurrection from the dead , according to the Spirit of holiness, Jesus Christ our Lord, Romans 6:5 For if we have become united with [Him] in the likeness of His death, certainly we shall be also [in the likeness] of His resurrection (Baptism)
Nothing without Resurrection	1 st Cointhians 15:13-14 But if there is no resurrection of the dead, not even Christ has been raised: and if Christ has not been raised, then our preaching is vain, your faith also is vain.
Christ Victorious	1st Cointhians 15:21 For since by a man [came] death (Adam), by a man also [came] the resurrection of the dead.

	Philippians 3:10 that I may know Him, and the power of His resurrection and the fellowship Of His sufferings, being conformed to His death;
2 Resurrections	Revelation 20:5-6 The rest of the dead did not come to life until the thousand years were completed. This is the first resurrection. Blessed and holy is the one who has a part in the first resurrection;
	1 st Resurrection = righteous, Resurrection of Believers 2 nd Resurrection = non-righteous, after Millennium kingdom, (1,000 years)(Holding in Hell)
	<u>3 Stages of 1st Resurrection:</u>
1 st stage	Matthew 27:51-52 And behold, the veil of the temple was torn in two from top to bottom, and the earth shook; and the rocks were split, and the tombs were opened; and many bodies of the saints who had fallen asleep were raised;
2 nd stage Rapture	1 st Corinthians 15:52 in a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trumpet; for the trumpet will sound, and the dead will be raised imperishable, and we shall be changed.
3 rd stage 2 nd Resurrection Unrighteous	7 years after Rapture, end of tribulation period, saved during tribulation period, 144,000 Revelation 20:12 And I saw the dead, the great and the small, standing before the throne, and books were opened; and another book was opened, which is [the book] of life; and the dead were judged from the things which were written in the books, according to their deeds.
Death defeated with Christ's Resurrection	1 st Corinthians 15:54-55 But when this perishable will have put on the imperishable, and this mortal will have put on immortality, then will come about the saying that is written, "DEATH IS SWALLOWED UP in victory. "O DEATH, WHERE IS YOUR VICTORY? O DEATH, WHERE IS YOUR STING?"
