| Scripture usages                                | Genesis 49:18 (Jacob) For Thy salvation I wait, O LORD.  |
| Scripture Theme - wait                          | Exodus 14:13 And Moses said unto the people, Fear ye not, <b>stand still, and see the salvation of</b> the LORD, which he will shew to you to day: for the Egyptians whom ye have seen to day, ye shall see them again no more for ever.<br><br>Deliverance of the Israelites from the Egyptians, deliverance from evil and danger |
| Eternity  | Hebrews 2:3 How shall we escape, if we <b>neglect</b> so great salvation; which at the first began to be spoken by the Lord, and was confirmed unto us by them that heard him;   |
| <b>Who saves us?</b>                            | Acts 4:12 Neither is there salvation in any other: for there is none other name (Jesus) under heaven given among men, whereby we must be saved.<br><br>Other names won't work! Allah, Mother Mary, Joseph Smith, Wealth, Buddha  |
| Jesus Said                                      | John 14:6 Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me.   |
| <b>What are we saved from?</b>                  | Innumerable  |
| Saved from Adamic Curse<br>Read Genesis 3:15-19 | Genesis 3:17 and hast eaten of the tree, of which I commanded thee, saying, thou shall not eat of it:  |
| Curses we got from Adam                         | Enmity between satan and us, physical death, martial strife, thorns and thistles, struggle to live, soil cursed, painful childbirth  |
| Saved from sin nature<br>We all have sin nature | 1 <sup>st</sup> Corinthians 15:22 For as in Adam all die, even so in Christ shall all be made alive.   |
| Redemption = by his Blood                       | The purchase back of something that had been lost, by the payment of a ransom<br>Jesus redeemed back the things lost to the enemy in the garden.   |
| Curse of the Law                                | Book of the Law. (Torah=Law) 1 <sup>st</sup> five books of the Bible. 613 commandments   |
| Saved from Curse of the Law                     | Galations 3:13 Christ hath <b>redeemed us</b> from the curse of the law, being made a curse for us: for it is written, Cursed is every one that hangeth on a tree:   |
| Forget to do a commandment?                     | James 2:10 For whoever keeps the whole law and yet stumbles in one [point,] he has become guilty of all.   |
| Saved from our sins                             | Deliverance or redemption from sin and its consequences.<br><br>Matthew 1:21 And she shall bring forth a son, and thou shalt call his name JESUS:  |

| Saved from Damnation of Hell       | Matthew 23:33 Ye serpents, ye generation of vipers, how can ye escape the damnation of hell?  |
| Saved from – Death and Hell        | John 5:24 (Jesus) He that heareth my word, and believeth on him that sent me, hath everlasting life, and shall not come into condemnation; but is <b>passed from death unto life.</b>                         |

| <b>How do we obtain Salvation?</b> | Acts 3:19 (Peter) <b>Repent</b> ye therefore, and be converted, that your sins may be blotted out, when the times of refreshing shall come from the presence of the Lord;                                     |
| Repent                             | Repent – Change your mind and purpose after knowledge (guilt, helplessness)   |
| Receive                            | John 1:12 But as many as <b>received him</b> , to them gave he power to become the sons of God, even to them that believe on his name:  |

| Testify                            | Romans 10:10 For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.   |
| Book of Life                       | Revelation 3:5 He that overcometh, the same shall be clothed in white raiment; and I will not blot out his name out of the book of life, but I will confess his name before my Father, and before his angels. |
| Walk in him                        | 1 <sup>st</sup> John 1:7 But if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship one with another, and the blood of Jesus Christ his Son cleanseth us from all sin.                            |
| Need to give earnest heed          | Hebrews 2:1 Therefore we ought to give the more earnest heed to the things which we have heard, lest at any time we should let them slip.   |
|                                    | We all slip up: we repent, we confess, we ask forgiveness. Less and less on the road.   |
| <b>Aren't you thankful?</b>        | Colossians 3:15 And let the peace of God rule in your hearts, to the which also ye are called in one body; and be ye thankful.  |
