

#New Testament Commandments Part 7 – NASB  
#301-350, 1<sup>st</sup> Corinthians 6:15 to 14:31

#301 1st Corinthians 6:15 Shall I then take away the members of Christ and make them members of a prostitute? May it never be!

#302 1st Corinthians 6:18 Flee immorality

#303 1st Corinthians 6:20 For you have been bought with a price: therefore glorify God in your body

#304 1st Corinthians 7:23 The husband must fulfill his duty to his wife, and likewise also the wife to her husband

#305 1st Corinthians 7:4 The wife does not have authority over her own body, but the husband does; and likewise also the husband does not have authority over his own body, but the wife does

#306 1st Corinthians 7:5 Stop depriving one another, except by agreement for a time, so that you may devote yourselves to prayer, and come together again so that Satan will not tempt you because of your lack of self-control

#307 1st Corinthians 7:8 But I say to the unmarried and to widows that it is good for them if they remain even as I

#308 1st Corinthians 7:10 But to the married I give instructions, not I, but the Lord, that the wife should not leave her husband

#309 1st Corinthians 7:11 (but if she does leave, she must remain unmarried, or else be reconciled to her husband), and that the husband should not divorce his wife

#310 1st Corinthians 7:17 Only, as the Lord has assigned to each one, as God has called each, in this manner let him walk

#311 1st Corinthians 7:18 Was any man called when he was already circumcised? He is not to become uncircumcised. Has anyone been called in uncircumcision? He is not to be circumcised

#312 1st Corinthians 7:20 Each man must remain in that condition in which he was called

#301-350, 1<sup>st</sup> Corinthians 6:15 to 14:31

#313 1st Corinthians 7:21 Were you called while a slave? Do not worry about it; but if you are able also to become free, rather do that

#314 1st Corinthians 7:23 You were bought with a price; do not become slaves of men

#315 1st Corinthians 7:24 Brethren, each one is to remain with God in that condition in which he was called

#316 1st Corinthians 7:27 Are you bound to a wife? Do not seek to be released. Are you released from a wife? Do not seek a wife

#317 1st Corinthians 7:27 Do you not know that those who run in a race all run, but only one receives the prize? Run in such a way that you may win.

#318 1st Corinthians 10:6 Now these things happened as examples for us, so that we would not crave evil things as they also craved

#319 1st Corinthians 10:7 Do not be idolaters, as some of them were;

#320 1st Corinthians 10:8 Nor let us act immorally, as some of them did, and twenty-three thousand fell in one day

#321 1st Corinthians 10:9 Nor let us try the Lord, as some of them did, and were destroyed by the serpents.

#322 1st Corinthians 10:10 Nor grumble, as some of them did, and were destroyed by the destroyer

#323 1st Corinthians 10:12 Therefore let him who thinks he stands take heed that he does not fall

#324 1st Corinthians 10:14 Therefore, my beloved, flee from idolatry

#325 1st Corinthians 10:21 You cannot drink the cup of the Lord and the cup of demons; you cannot partake of the table of the Lord and the table of demons.

#New Testament Commandments Part 7 – NASB  
#301-350, 1<sup>st</sup> Corinthians 6:15 to 14:31

#326 1st Corinthians 10:24 Let no one seek his own good, but that of his neighbor

#327 1st Corinthians 10:28 But if anyone says to you, “This is meat sacrificed to idols,” do not eat it, for the sake of the one who informed you, and for conscience’ sake

#328 1st Corinthians 10:32 Give no offense either to Jews or to Greeks or to the church of God;

#329 1st Corinthians 11:1 Be imitators of me, just as I also am of Christ

#330 1st Corinthians 11:4 Every man who has something on his head while praying or prophesying disgraces his head

#331 1st Corinthians 11:5 But every woman who has her head uncovered while praying or prophesying disgraces her head

#332 1st Corinthians 11:6 For if a woman does not cover her head, let her also have her hair cut off;

#333 1st Corinthians 11:7 For a man ought not to have his head covered, since he is the image and glory of God;

#334 1st Corinthians 11:13 Judge for yourselves: is it proper for a woman to pray to God with her head uncovered?

#335 1st Corinthians 11:24 This is My body, which is for you; do this in remembrance of Me.”

#336 1st Corinthians 11:25 “This cup is the new covenant in My blood; do this, as often as you drink it, in remembrance of Me.”

#337 1st Corinthians 11:27 Therefore whoever eats the bread or drinks the cup of the Lord in an unworthy manner, shall be guilty of the body and the blood of the Lord

#338 1st Corinthians 11:28 But a man must examine himself, and in so doing he is to eat of the bread and drink of the cup

#New Testament Commandments Part 7 – NASB  
#301-350, 1<sup>st</sup> Corinthians 6:15 to 14:31

#339 1st Corinthians 11:33 So then, my brethren, when you come together to eat, wait for one another

#340 1st Corinthians 11:34 If anyone is hungry, let him eat at home, so that you will not come together for judgment

#341 1st Corinthians 12:1 Now concerning spiritual gifts, brethren, I do not want you to be unaware

#342 1st Corinthians 14:1 Pursue love, yet desire earnestly spiritual gifts, but especially that you may prophesy

#343 1st Corinthians 14:13 Therefore let one who speaks in a tongue pray that he may interpret

#344 1st Corinthians 14:20 Brethren, do not be children in your thinking; yet in evil be infants, but in your thinking be mature

#345 1st Corinthians 14:26 Let all things be done for edification

#346 1st Corinthians 14:27 If anyone speaks in a tongue, it should be by two or at the most three, and each in turn, and one must interpret

#347 1st Corinthians 14:28 but if there is no interpreter, he must keep silent in the church; and let him speak to himself and to God

#348 1st Corinthians 14:29 Let two or three prophets speak, and let the others pass judgment

#349 1st Corinthians 14:30 But if a revelation is made to another who is seated, the first one must keep silent

#350 1st Corinthians 14:31 For you can all prophesy one by one, so that all may learn and all may be exhorted
