The six articles of furniture in the Temple are all pictorial representations of parts of our relationship with God:

The Brazen Altar – The benefits of the blood

The Laver – Personal cleansing

The Candlestick – The seven aspects of the Holy Spirit: Isaiah 11:1-2
Spirit of the Lord, Wisdom, Understanding, Council, Might, Knowledge, Fear of the Lord

The Table of Shewbread – Getting a daily Rhema from God

Altar of Incense – Praise and Worship

Holy of Holies – Prayer for your family, church, nations and missions.

Make Declaration!

Ezekial 37:1-10 Lets Prophesize over ourselves, our family, over all things God has granted and will give us. Luke 7:7, Mark 4:39

Romans 10:10 for with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation. Enemy can't read your mind – speak the WORD.

2nd Peter 1:4 whereby he hath granted unto us his precious and exceeding great promises; that through these ye may become partakers of the divine nature, having escaped from the corruption that is in that world by lust.

2nd Corinthians 1:20 For however many are the promises of God, in him they are "Yes."

Find the promise that deal with your need and make declaration. Ex – Children Saved
Why declaration – part of salvation, our walk with God, builds you up, hurts the enemy and reduces fiery darts.

Speak the Word – Luke 7:7, Mark 4:39. We have all the power within us through Jesus Christ and his Spirit.

The Brazen Altar – The benefits of the blood.

Dear Jesus Christ – Always start praying with Jesus name, don't wait until the end and give the enemy a chance to attack your words.

(1) **I worship** your blood. **I thank** you because your blood forgave all of my sins. All of the sins that I have committed, and all of the sins which I am going to commit in the future. You have forgiven me eternally. (Blood is flowing that a spring).

(2) Jesus **I worship** you because through the blood. **You have delivered** me from the power of satan and the world. You moved me to the Kingdom of Jesus Christ. Now **I am** living in your Son's Kingdom through the blood of Jesus Christ. (You were living like the devil)

(3) Jesus through the stripes you received at the courtyard of Pilate, my sickness and diseases have been taken away since 2000 years ago. **I declare** that because of the blood of Jesus Christ, that Christ blood speaks better than the blood of Abraham, and so I praise you. **I praise** you for divine healing through the blood of Jesus Christ.

(4) Dear Jesus, through your blood **I have been redeemed** from the Adamic curse. Because of Adam the earth was cursed. The earth was to bring forth thistle and thorns. That is the symbol of all the failure in life. Oh God, you took our curse on the cross. Because the bible says that Christ has redeemed us from the curse of the law, making a curse for us for it is written, Cursed is everyone that hangs on a tree that the blessing of Abraham might come upon the Gentiles. (**Redeemed - the purchase back of something that had been lost, by the payment of a ransom.**)

So through your blood **I am completely delivered** from the curse. **I am delivered** from failure and poverty. **I am free** from the curse. **I have the blessings** of Abraham. **I am a blessed person.**

(5) Dear Jesus, through your blood **I am delivered** from death and hell. Jesus, you died and you were resurrected. You Conquered death and hell. You brought the Glory of the Kingdom of Heaven. By the blood of Jesus Christ **I am completely delivered** from death and hell and am now living in the Glory of Jesus Christ. **I am** a member of the Kingdom of God. **I have** the eternal kingdom in me so praise God because of the blood. **I worship** Jesus and praise him because of the blood.

The Laver – Personal Cleansing

Father, make me holy and sanctified. Father, sanctified me. Father, sanctified me in your power. The Lord's prayer. (say the). Set apart, we need set apart for holiness. (John 17:19)

Father, give me grace to forgive and love. Father, if you give me anymore strength, then I will love them. Father, make me a very humble and meek person. Oh God, let me be very soft and loving in my heart to my Christians. (Commanded to forgive, not required to love),

Oh God, help me to live according to the measure of faith that you have gave me. Don't make me proud. Make me live according to the measure of faith you gave me. (Credit Cards)

The Table of Shewbread – Getting a daily Rhema from God

Lord, **I envy** the Word of God. **I admire** and love the Word of God. I long after the Word of God. I read, I study, **I believe**, I act, I thank you, and I want to teach this Word of God. So, Lord give me a new fresh revelation in my heart. My heart is panting for the Word of God. Please give me a new revelation.

Altar of Incense – Praise and Worship

I really appreciate you. **You delivered** me from sin. **You delivered me** from worldliness. **You delivered me** from sickness. **You delivered me** from the curse. **You delivered** from death. You are the God who is the foundation of my life. **You are** the purpose of my life. **You are** the value of my life. I worship you, the God who created the heaven and the earth and all things in them. I worship you. I thank you.

The Ark of the Covenant

I am eternally forgiven. **I am** eternally declared righteous. **I am** eternally saved. **I am** eternally blessed by his blood covenant. I thank you dear Heavenly Father. I am now your family member with my father. **I am** his child and I joy in triune God. **I am** living in the Hollies of Hollies. Father, now I have many requests. I want you to hear them and help me. (Go now into your prayer list).

The Ten Commandments

1. You shall have no other Gods before me
2. You shall make for yourself an idol or any likeness of what is in heaven above or on the earth beneath or in the water under the earth.
3. You shall not take the name of the Lord your God in vain.
4. Remember the Sabbath day to keep it holy.
