

Justification	Using NASB translation, some KJV
Meaning	It is the judicial act of God, by which he pardons all the sins of those who believe in Christ, and accounts, accepts, and treats them as righteous in the eye of the law. (Court of Heaven)
	<u>Justified: just as if we never sinned:</u>
Your Words	Matthew 12:37 For by thy words thou shalt be justified , and by thy words thou shalt be condemned.
Words w Heart	Justification Words from the heart = Please come into my heart, forgive me.
Jesus Said	Luke 18:13-14 "But the tax-gatherer, standing some distance away, was even unwilling to lift up his eyes to heaven, but was beating his breast, saying, 'God, be merciful to me, the sinner!'
By his Words	I tell you, this man went down to his house justified rather than the other: for every one that exalteth himself shall be abased; and he that humbleth himself shall be exalted.
Belief Works	Acts 13:39 And by him (Jesus) all that believe are justified from all things , from which ye could not be justified by the law of Moses .
Works Don't	Belief works. Works will never work. Rules and regulations (law) don't work. We are to combine belief with works. Tons of religious groups want us to obey rules and regulations.
	Galatians 2:16 nevertheless knowing that a man is not justified by the works of the Law but through faith in Christ Jesus...
The Law	Romans 3:20 Therefore by the deeds of the law there shall no flesh be justified in his sight (God): for by the law is the knowledge of sin.
Justification is Free	Romans 3:24 Being justified freely by his grace through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus: Grace = getting what you don't desire
Justified= Peace	Romans 5:1 Therefore being justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ:
1st Corinthians 6:10-11	Or do you not know that the unrighteous shall not inherit the kingdom of God? Do not be deceived; neither fornicators, nor idolaters, nor adulterers, nor effeminate, nor homosexuals, nor thieves, nor [the] covetous, nor drunkards, nor revilers, nor swindlers, shall inherit the kingdom of God. And such were some of you; but you were washed, but you were sanctified, but you were justified in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ,
