Considered blessed that he was able to talk about his passing with the family
Conclusion: Death
Unless the rapture or God intervening, we are all going to die (Pass)
There might be suffering but it is only for a moment in time and Jesus will help you.
The Glory or Jesus and Heaven awaits us.
